INTRO

REVIEW

1. Clearly, God has introduced a new and different model for the priesthood. (7:1-10)
2. Clearly, God has brought in new and different qualifications for the priesthood. (7:11-28)
3. Clearly, God has written a new and different instruction manual for the priesthood. (8:1-11)
4. Clearly, God has established a new and different center of worship. (9:1-14)
5. Clearly, God has provided a new and different means of access to worship. (9:15-28)
6. Clearly, God has given church-age believers a new and different ability to fulfill the commitments of worship. (10:1-18)

MESSAGE All three members of the Trinity testify that atonement for sin is accomplished through the work of Messiah...not through the Law.

THE LAW...(10:1-4)

- cannot perfect worshippers (1)
- cannot remove the guilt of sin from worshippers (2-3)
- cannot remove sin’s penalty, sin’s power, or sin’s presence (4)

GOD THE FATHER...(10:5-10)

- did not send the Son, the Messiah, to offer more ineffective sacrifices (5a-6)
- sent the Son, the Messiah, to do the father’s will by offering His own body (5b-7)
- by sending the Son, the Messiah, eliminates the need for the sacrifices and sets apart the worshipper for spiritual growth and blessing(8-10)

GOD THE SON...(10:11-14)

- by His coming, shows that the ministry of the priest is ineffective (11)
- by His one sacrifice, for all time, satisfies God the Father (12-13)
- by His one sacrifice, for all time, perfects those who draw near in worship (14)

GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT... (10:15-18)

- testifies to church age believers that Messiah’s work enables them to participate in the blessings of the New covenant with Israel (15-17)
- affirms that when sin is actually forgiven, not just passed over, there is no longer any need for the Levitical system (18)
